### **USER LICENCE FOR TERRITORIAL DATABANKS**

These General Service Conditions (hereinafter “GSC”), divided up into 13 articles, regulate the “Territorial Databank” Service of Poste Italiane S.p.A. (hereinafter “Poste”).

#### **Article 1 – VALUE OF ATTACHMENTS**

The application form and the attachments listed below are an integral part of the General Service Conditions and make up this Contract (hereinafter “Contract”) drawn up between the Client (hereinafter also referred to as the “Licensee”) and Poste Italiane S.p.A. (hereinafter “Poste”).

#### **ATTACHMENT 1 – “Description of Territorial Databanks and Pertinent Price List”**

## ARTICLE 2 – INTRODUCTION AND DEFINITIONS

Poste is the owner of the Territorial Databanks, defined and explained below, which contain toponymic information and territorial and geographical data, the use of which will enable the Client who so requests using the pertinent application form to check and correct geopostal address archives, conduct territorial analysis, and create software applications for the Client's own use or on behalf of third parties.

Under this Contract for the supply of a user licence for one of the Territorial Databanks, the Client becomes a licensee and acquires the right to use the aforementioned Databank within the limits and terms specified in Article 5 of this Contract.

### 2.1. Definitions

Within the framework of this Contract, the terms indicated below are defined as follows:

- **“Territorial Databank”**: represents the service that identifies the specific databank in which the Client party to this Contract is interested, explicitly indicated on the application form in the section “Supply of a Licence to Use the Territorial Databanks”. The types of Databanks available to the Client, broken down in Attachment 1, are as follows:

- **CAP Professional**
- **CAP Street File**
- **CAP Zone**
- **CAP Delivery Points**

**“Territorial Databanks”**: designates the range of services offered by Poste with this Contract.

- **“Price List”**: contains the complete list of the Territorial Databanks that Poste makes available, the versions available and the prices in relation to the purpose for which they are to be used. The List makes up Attachment 1.

- the **“User Licence”**: is the non-exclusive user licence provided by Poste for the Territorial Databank requested by the Licensee by undersigning the pertinent Application Form, which permits the Licensee to use the Territorial Databank requested under the terms and conditions and within the limits set out in Article 4 of this Contract.

- **“Licensee”**: designates the person and/or company that accepts this Contract.

- **“End client”**: designates the third party to which the service/software shall be provided by the Licensee within the framework of the “Licence for commercial use for the embedding of the encrypted information”

- **“Documentation”**: refers to all the paper and digital material belonging to Poste related to the Territorial Databank, including the technical specifications, the supply of samples if pertinent and the instructions provided for the purposes and under the terms of this Contract.

- **“Data”**: refers to all the data contained in each of the different types of Territorial Databank, belonging to Poste.

## ARTICLE 3 – PURPOSE

This Contract sets out the conditions for the offer of the Territorial Databanks on the part of Poste, as well as those relating to the User Licence for the Databank provided by Poste at the request of the Licensee by undersigning the pertinent application form.

#### ARTICLE 4 – INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The following trademarks are the property of Poste: **CAP, CAP Professional, CAP Street File, CAP Zone, CAP Delivery Points**. Poste holds the industrial and intellectual property rights to the above-mentioned trademarks and to the Territorial Databanks, as regulated by Legislative Decree No. 30 of 10.2.2005 (Industrial Property Code) and by Law No. 633 of 22.4.1941 (Copyright Law).

Poste Italiane retains legal ownership of the Databank, of any copy of the Data and the Documentation for which this Contract provides a licence, as well as all relevant rights not granted

The Licensee undertakes to protect the Territorial Databank and the Documentation from unauthorised use, reproduction, destruction or publication from the date on which they are received, with the diligence requested by Article 1176, para. 2 of the Italian Civil Code.

The Licensee acknowledges that a certain amount of so-called “bait records” have been deliberately introduced by Poste into the Territorial Databank in order to verify that the use made by the Licensee of said Databank is compliant with the usage rights described in Article 4 of this Contract. These “bait records”, included in the databank deposited with the Italian Society of Authors and Publishers (SIAE), do not in any way adversely affect the correct use and functioning of the Territorial Databank.

#### Article 5 – RIGHTS OF USE

The Licensee is authorised to use the Territorial Databank in compliance with the specifications below, depending on the type of user licence granted following the request made on the pertinent application form, and in all cases in compliance with legislation and regulations currently in force, with particular regard to Article 181 bis of Law No. 633/1941, where applicable.

Poste forbids uses that have not been expressly provided for, including – but not limited to – the publication on paper or on internet of the Territorial Databank, either in its entirety or a substantial part thereof.

#### 5.1. Types of Licences

##### A. Licence for Internal Use

In execution of this Contract, the Licence for Internal Use permits the Licensee to use the Territorial Databank selected exclusively for:

- processing the addresses contained in the archives belonging to him/her in order to update the zip codes or correct place names;
- conducting territorial analysis and drawing up statistics for use within his/her company;
- including the data in software applications exclusively for internal use. Company applications must be internet-based and must not be used by third party clients.

Under no circumstances may the Databank be transmitted or transferred to third parties.

The licence is granted for an unlimited period of time (permanently): updates may be purchased at the List price at the request of the Licensee within 36 months from the undersigning of this Contract. After 36 months the Licensee shall be obliged to undersign a new Contract.

##### B. Licence for Commercial “Service” Use

In execution of this Contract, thanks to the Licence for **Commercial “Service”** Use the Licensee can use the Territorial Databank selected exclusively for:

- processing the addresses contained in the archives belonging to him/her in order to update the zip codes or correct place names;
- processing address archives on behalf of third parties (data cleaning services, batch clearing of archives);
- conducting territorial analysis and drawing up statistics for use within his/her company;
- conducting territorial analysis and drawing up statistics for third party clients, including the Data in summary-type reports or marketing studies.

Under no circumstances may the Databank be transmitted or transferred to third parties.

The Licence for Commercial “Service” Use is granted for one year upon payment of an annual fee which includes the supply of all the updates published during the period for which this Contract is valid. This Contract is not tacitly renewable.

### **C. Licence for Commercial “Development” Use**

In execution of this Contract, the Licence for Commercial “Development” Use permits the Licensee to use the Territorial Databank selected for inclusion in his/her own software applications for internal use or in software applications destined for use by his/her clients both in “desktop” and “on-line” (internet) mode. The Licence for Commercial Development Use requires the Licensee to integrate the Territorial Databank into the above-mentioned software applications in such a way as to ensure the Territorial Databank cannot be used outside of such applications, thus guaranteeing Poste that said Databank shall be protected and assuming full responsibility for such protection.

Under no circumstances may the Databank be transmitted or ceded to third parties.

The Licence for Commercial “Development” Use is granted for an unlimited period of time (permanently): updates may be purchased at the List price at the request of the Licensee within 36 months from the undersigning of this Contract. After 36 months the Licensee shall be obliged to undersign a new Contract.

### **5.2 - Copies and back-up activities**

The Licensee may make a copy of the Territorial Databank for archiving purposes during the period for which this Contract is valid.

### **Article 6 – DURATION AND EFFECTIVENESS OF CONTRACT**

This Contract shall be valid from the date on which the pertinent application form is signed by the Client for the period set out in said application form, according to the type of User Licence selected by the Client on the form.

For the Commercial Service Licence, this Contract may be extended for a period of one year at the express request of the Licensee, who shall undersign a new application form no later than 30 days before the expiry date.

### **Article 7 – LICENSEE’S OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES**

By signing the relevant application form, the Licensee accepts these conditions and undertakes to satisfy the following obligations throughout the entire validity of this Contract:

- S/he shall neither remove nor conceal wording regarding patents, authorship rights, trademarks and/or property rights belonging to Poste Italiane and contained in the Territorial Databank or in the Documentation.
- S/he shall respect the Intellectual Property rights of Poste Italiane defined in Article 3 of this Contract.
- S/he shall not extract or transfer onto any kind of support or means of publication, lend, cede, hire, lease – free of charge or upon payment – the Data or any part thereof.

The Licensee in possession of the Licence for Commercial Development Use which involves the integration of information undertakes to comply with the obligations in this article also on behalf of his/her clients, pursuant to Article 1381 of the Italian Civil Code.

The Licensee therefore relieves Poste of all responsibilities, damages and expenses related to any action, demands and requests for recoupment also from third parties connected to or deriving from the execution of this Contract insofar as is pertinent to him/her, or failure to comply with its terms.

### **Article 8 – POSTE’S OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES**

#### **8.1 Completeness and accuracy of the Data**

The Territorial Databanks are subject to ongoing procedures to improve and review the Data on the part of Poste. Therefore, given that the Data are by their very nature subject to changes, Poste cannot guarantee that they are complete and accurate where changes may have taken place.

## 8.2. Updates

Updates to the Territorial Databank shall be published by Poste at intervals established by the same and in relation to the type of Territorial Databank selected. The updates shall consist of the supply of the complete, updated territorial databank.

## 8.3 Damages

Poste shall be liable solely and exclusively for damages directly and immediately arising from its own conduct in the execution of this Contract.

In any case, Poste shall not be liable vis-à-vis the Customer or third parties directly or indirectly related to the Customer, for poor service caused by:

- a) misuse of the Territorial Databank on the part of the Client;
- b) malfunction or breakdown of the Customer's computer equipment;
- c) suspension and/or interruption of the electrical power supply;
- d) suspension and/or interruption of the Internet connection.

## 8.4. Supply of the Territorial Databank

Poste guarantees the supply of the Databank selected via download, as indicated at point a), or via dispatch of a CD ROM as specified at point b).

### Via download from Poste website

The Databank selected shall be supplied via download from the website [www.poste.it](http://www.poste.it) and shall be made available to the Client within 20 days of the undersigning of this application form. The Client may download the Databank after having registered with the site, by following the instructions that will be sent to him/her at the email address indicated above.

### b) Via dispatch of a CD-ROM

The Client may receive the Databank selected on a CD ROM, provided the appropriate request is made by means of a registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt addressed to Poste Italiane - Servizi Postali - Marketing Media e Editoria - viale Europa 175 – 00144 Rome, Italy.

In this case, within 20 days of receipt of the above-mentioned request, Poste will dispatch said CD ROM by insured mail to the Client's address as indicated in the pertinent section of the application form.

The general postal service conditions as per Ministerial Decree of 1 October 2008, published in the Official Gazette No. 242 of 15 October 2001, shall apply to delivery via insured mail.

Any delivery sent via an express courier at the explicit request of the Client shall be at his/her own expense, including customs duty, import taxes and other administrative delivery expenses.

## Article 9 – COSTS AND TERMS OF INVOICING AND PAYMENT

Prices for the User Licence for the Territorial Databanks are included in Attachment 1: **"Description of Territorial Databanks and Pertinent Price List"**.

Upon the stipulation of this Contract, or upon updating/renewal of the same, Poste will issue invoices based on the prices reported in the attached list and according to the Licence for the CAP Databank selected on the application form.

For the Licence for Commercial Development Use, the price shall be determined according to the number of end clients to whom the databank shall be ceded in the course of the initial supply period. Therefore, at the end of the year, Poste will issue a credit note or an adjustment invoice according to the effective number of clients.

The invoice shall be sent to the address indicated by the Licensee on the Application Form.

The Client must settle the invoice within 30 days from the date of issue of the invoice, in one of the ways indicated below:

- Pre-completed post office payment slip sent together with the invoice;
- Post office postal transfer or online postal transfer if the Customer has a BPIOL account;
- Post office wire transfer or online wire transfer

For clients living abroad, the BIC SWIFT is as follows:

- BPPIITRRXXX for countries belonging to the EURO area
- POSOIT22XXX for countries not belonging to the EURO area.

Without prejudice to the provisions contained in Legislative Decree No. 231 of October 9 2002, in the event of late payment, the Licensee must pay, on the basis of a specific notice by Poste, arrears interest equal to the interest rate of the European Central Bank's main refinancing instrument, applied to its most recent refinancing transaction made on the first calendar day of the half-year in question, increased by two percentage points.

## Article 10 – RESOLUTION – AMENDMENTS – WITHDRAWAL

### 10.1.

Pursuant to and for the effects and purposes of Article 1454 of the Italian Civil Code, in the event of a breach in one of the clauses of this contract, it is hereby agreed that the non-defaulting party shall order the other party, in writing via registered letter with return receipt, to fulfil this Contractual requirements within 30 days, with it being specifically stated that once said period has lapsed without action being taken, this Contract shall be taken as cancelled, without prejudice to the right to compensation of any damages incurred.

This Contract shall also be legally cancelled, as per Article 1456 of the Italian Civil Code – without prejudice to compensation of damages and all other legal action, in the following cases:

- a) default of obligations as per Article 4, letters b), d), e), f);
- b) default of obligations as per Article 5.

### 10.2.

Poste reserves the right to alter the current terms and conditions, including prices, also due to technical, working, financial and management requirements. Licensees shall be notified of any changes via registered mail with return receipt, to the address shown in the application form. In the event that the Licensee does not intend to accept the changes, s/he is entitled to withdraw from this Contract by sending a registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt to the address of Poste indicated on the application form within 30 days of receipt of the notification of the changes. Withdrawal shall be effective from the last day of the month when Poste received notification from the Customer.

### 10.3

It is in any case understood that in the event of extinction of this Contract for any reason the Licensee undertakes to uninstall, remove and destroy all the Data and all the Documentation and any copies made thereof, modifications thereto or portions thereof combined in any form, in their entirety or part thereof, and to provide Poste with a declaration, under his/her own responsibility, attesting to the uninstallation and destruction of the above-mentioned material of Poste within .... from the expiry date or extinction of this Contract.

## Article 11 – LITIGATION AND COURT OF JURISDICTION

For all disputes that may arise from the interpretation or execution of this Contract and that cannot be settled out-of-court, the court of jurisdiction shall be the Court of Rome.

## **Article 12 – PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING (Statement pursuant to article 13 of Legislative Decree 196/03)**

Within the framework of the processing of the personal data supplied by the Client for the provision of the service, Poste Italiane S.p.A. will act in its capacity as Data Manager in full compliance with the provisions set out in Legislative Decree no. 196/03, the Code for the protection of personal data.

- **Source of personal data**

The personal data are provided directly by the subject to which they refer.

- **Purpose of personal data processing**

Poste would like to inform Clients that the personal details they provide may be processed for one of the following purposes:

1. To provide the service requested.
2. To comply with the obligations provided for by the law, by regulations and EU rules, or measures established by public Authorities.
3. To respond to specific requests made by the Client, prior to the closing of the contract.
4. With the consent of the Client, for reasons instrumental to Poste's activity, relating to activities that are not directly linked to the services requested by the Client, but are useful in order to improve them or to provide information on new services offered by Poste, the Poste Group or third-party companies. These activities may be carried out for promotional or commercial reasons, or in order to directly offer products and services of the Poste Italiane S.p.A. Group by means of letters, telephone contacts, automated call systems without the intervention of an operator (such as, for example, fax, e-mail, text messages, etc.) as well as for market research – also via third parties – or to gauge the level of satisfaction of customers with the services and products offered by the Poste Italiane Group or companies to which your data may be provided. With the consent of the Client, Poste may also carry out orientation activities for the use or purchase of the CAP Territorial Databank and for client profiling activities regarding individual preferences and consumer choices.

The above-mentioned data may also be processed in relation to participation on the part of the Client in prize promotions organised by Poste Italiane S.p.A..

- **Mandatory and optional nature of the provision of personal data and consequences deriving from failure to give consent**

It is mandatory to provide data for reasons 1), 2) and 3) above. Failure to do so may render execution of the contract impossible. The provision of said data for the reasons at number 4) above is optional; the processing of data for this reason requires the consent of the Client, which may be expressed either upon activation of the service requested or at a later date, for as long as the service is provided to the Client. The provision of data for these reasons is not mandatory; failure to give consent will not invalidate the contractual relationship, but will prevent the Client from receiving information on promotions organised by Poste Italiane, the Poste Italiane Group and third parties. Poste may send letters and/or emails to the Client containing commercial information regarding similar products and services offered, provided that the Client does not express his opposition to such correspondence by contacting the pro tempore head of Postal Services at the Marketing Office of Poste Italiane.

- **Terms of personal data processing**

Personal data are processed for the purposes indicated above using manual and/or IT and telematic instruments in ways that are strictly related to the reasons for their use and in such a way as to guarantee said data remain secure and confidential. Without prejudice to the above, Poste undertakes to adopt all the physical and logical organisational measures necessary as per articles 31 – 39 of Legislative Decree No. 196/03 and Attachment B thereto: Technical regulations regarding minimum security measures. Clients' personal data will be held only for as long as is strictly necessary for the execution of the contract, with specific reference to marketing reasons, for the length of time provided for by the pertinent regulations. Poste undertakes to ensure that confidentiality is maintained by its employees and assistants with regard to the confidentiality obligation regarding all the personal data it will become aware of while performing its services, and not to disclose any information or documentation acquired.

- **Categories of subjects to which personal data may be provided**

Poste Italiane, in order to ensure the proper functioning of all the activities necessary for the provision of the service requested, may, where necessary, give notification of the Client's personal data to third-party companies, including the companies belonging to the Poste Group, exclusively for the purposes necessary to provide the service requested. Poste may also provide personal data to individuals, companies or professional studios that provide assistance and advice to Poste Italiane, to subjects to which notification is compulsory as a result of legal regulations or orders from the Authorities and to subjects involved in carrying out activities that

are closely related to the provision of the service or to technical maintenance (including the maintenance of network equipment and electronic communication networks). The above-mentioned subjects shall operate completely independently as separate Owners of the processed information or in the capacity of Managers or Appointees nominated for the purpose by Poste, the list of which is updated continuously and always available from Poste Italiane. Clients' personal data shall be known to Poste staff members that have been expressly nominated as data processing Managers or Appointees. The data processed by Poste will not be disclosed. Personal data will not be provided to other subjects without the consent of the Client, except for cases provided for under art. 24 of the Privacy Code.

• Rights as per article 7 of the Privacy Code

In order to exercise your rights as per art. 7 of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 (access, rectification, integration, removal of data, refusal of consent, etc.), Clients may contact the Data Processing Manager at the Postal Services Department of Poste Italiane's Marketing Office, located in Viale Europa 175, Rome. You may also contact the aforementioned Data Manager if you wish to know the names of any additional parties involved in data processing. Those in charge of processing shall be selected by the Data Manager and work under its direct supervision, abiding by the instructions given by said Data Manager.

**Article 13 – TAX CHARGES**

This Contract is subject to application of duties and registration fees pursuant to current legislation.

**Article 14 – FINAL CLAUSES**

The invalidity of an article or part of an article shall not automatically imply the invalidity of the whole Contract.

This Contract and its attachments shall represent the only source regulating relations between the Parties.
